“All Things”
1 Corinthians 13:7

1. Our passage tells us that God’s love affects all things. Paul purposely chose these words to emphasize there is no situation that is too hard for God. How does this fact comfort us and cause us to trust in Him more than our circumstances?

2. The word “bear” in our verse has to do with being a covering, a protection...it has to do with covering the faults and mistakes of others. Read 1 Peter 4:8. How do we apply God’s love with regards to bearing all things when it comes to our spouses...our family...our relationships?

3. Rather than looking to scrutinize everyone in cynicism, the first reaction when controlled by God’s love is to believe the best about them first. How do we practically apply this principle in our marriages...our family...our relationships?

4. Read Philippians 4:11-13. How does this verse speak to enduring all things? How can this truth minister to you in your current trials? How do we share this truth with others facing difficulties?

5. Is there a wall that you have built between you and God based on circumstances in the past or currently? How can you now take the fact that God’s love for you bears, believes, hopes and endures all things and, with His help, tear down that wall?
