

# **Home Fellowship Questions**

## **1 Corinthians 2: 1-2**

### **“One Answer”**

- 1) When there are times in our lives when we doubt God’s love for us, how can looking to the cross help us see His love for us now? Read Hebrews 12:2. What was the “joy” that was set before Jesus as He endured the cross? Do you see our Lord as a “personal” God? What does that mean to you?
  
- 2) Describe a time in your life where you wondered if God had abandoned or forgotten you. Read Isaiah 49:14-16. In light of “Jesus Christ and Him Crucified” do these verses take on even more meaning? How? How do we trust that we do not know what we are asking and that the Lord knows what is best for us?
  
- 3) When dealing with addiction, depression or bitterness, how would the world around us counsel us? How is the cross of Christ so totally opposite from the world’s way? Is there anyone you know of that is dealing with any of these issues that you can take back to Jesus Christ and Him crucified for deliverance?
  
- 4) When sharing our faith with others, we have a tendency to get way more complicated than we need to. Why do you suppose that is? If you had 3 minutes or less...how would you share Jesus Christ and Him crucified with an unsaved person?
