Because You Claim to be God

John 10:32-42

1. In what way do we see the incredible power and grace of Jesus in verse 32? How have you seen God's power and grace in your life? Why does Jesus reason with the religious leaders instead of destroy them?
2. In verse 37 and 38, Jesus challenges the religious leaders to examine all that He said and did. Why did He do that? Why do so many people make up their minds about Jesus without doing a thorough examination as to who He is?
3. Jesus left Jerusalem and retreated back to the place where His public ministry began. Why did He do this? Why is it so important for us to prepare for spiritual battle? How do we prepare? Are you ready for battle?
4. Even though John the Baptist never did anything miraculous, Jesus referred to him as the greatest man born among women. What did John do that made him great? What makes what John did the number one priority in ministry?
5. People were continuing to believe in Jesus as a result of John's ministry even after he was dead. What can you do now that will continue to bring people to Christ long after you are gone?
