John 11:1-6

1. John begins this section of Scripture without immediately identifying the person that is sick of the particular sickness. What does this tell us about the main purpose of this miracle?

2. What was the first thing Martha and Mary did when they learned about their brothers sickness? What is the first thing we as Christians should do when we face difficulties in our lives? Why is this so important?

3. Martha and Mary's message is simple, clear and quick. What can we learn from this in regard to our prayer life? Notice that they do not give Jesus instruction as to what to do. Do you tend to tell Jesus how to answer your prayers?

4. John tells us that Jesus loved Martha, Mary and Lazarus perfectly. Yet, when He heard Lazarus was sick, He delayed three days before He went to Bethany? What three things does this tell us about the love of God, his purpose for us, and his timing in answering our prayers?
