“Do You Believe This?”

John 11: 17-27

- 1) The reality is that Jesus is never early and He is never late...He is always right on time. He is in complete control. He not only knows our situations, but pays particular attention to the details. Why should this truth cause us to trust, believe and relax in Him more?

- 2) How were Martha and Mary so different in their personalities? Do you see yourself more as a Martha or a Mary? Why? Even though our #1 priority, as followers of Jesus, is to sit at His feet...listening and learning...we are also called to serve Him and His body, the church. How do we make sure we have the proper balance between relationship and service?

- 3) We all deal with times of faith followed by times of frustration. In our weaker times, we can have a tendency to feel like Jesus is disappointed or frustrated in us. How did Jesus react to Martha's frustration? How does He react to our frustration and/or lack of faith? Why should this encourage us in our walk with Jesus?

- 4) As Christians, we can all look back to times in our lives where Jesus has worked mightily. In faith, we also look ahead to our incredible future with Him in eternity. Why then, do we have such a difficult time trusting Him with our current circumstances, problems and messes? How does Hebrews 13:8 help us in current struggles?
