**One of You Will Betray Me**  
**John 13:18-30**

1. Did Jesus know Judas would betray Him? If so, why did He choose Him? What does this tell us about Jesus?
  
2. Why did Jesus tell the disciples that He would be betrayed before it happened? Why does His Word warn us about things to come? Why should this strengthen our faith in Jesus?
  
3. There is no greater pain than being betrayed by someone you love. Have you ever been betrayed? If so, how did it make you feel? Why should our hurts and pains drive us to Jesus?
  
4. When Jesus announced that one of the twelve would betray Him, no one knew who it was. What does this tell us about Judas? What does this tell us about Jesus? What can we learn from this?
  
5. In what ways do we see the incredible grace, mercy and love of Jesus in verse 26? Why did Jesus express so much love for Judas?
