Luke 19:1-10

“Face to Face with Jesus”

- 1) When we are saved, our lives don't become easier...however, our lives are changed...how? Zaccheus was curious to see who Jesus was...to learn more about Him. Do you live a life that makes others around you curious about why you are different? How is your life different than theirs?
- 2) Scripture tells us that Jesus often got away from all distraction, alone by himself, for extended periods of time...often at inconvenient times no matter how busy He was...just to pray. What is the most difficult obstacle(s) between you and a fulfilling prayer life? What specific changes can you make to overcome these obstacles?
- 3) Jesus didn't care about political correctness or how it would affect his popularity when he brought salvation to Zaccheus. When you are presented with an opportunity to share the Gospel...do you look to see who else is around first? Do you concern yourself with what you think the outcome might be? How it may affect your job? Status? Health? If God were to ask...no tell you to do something that would adversely affect any of these, would you hesitate? Why or Why not? How do we overcome these fears in order to become effective tools in spreading the Gospel?
- 4) There was immediate and noticeable change in the life of Zaccheus after his face to face encounter with Jesus. We are not all called to sell what we have and give to the poor...but we are all called to do something. What is the Lord calling you to do? How can you know for sure? What do you need to do specifically to obey Him?
