## “Who Then Is This?”

### Mark 4:35-41

- 1) When difficulties and trials arise, often times our first inclination is to try to handle them on our own...in our own understanding. More times than not, what is the result of these efforts? What does Proverbs 3:5 & 6 tell us to do? What is the result promised here?
  
- 2) Read Romans 10:9. What three words describe the fundamental truth of Christianity? Why is it so important to have a true understanding of what it means that Jesus is our Lord?
  
- 3) Read Matthew 6:28-33. According to Jesus, whose responsibility is it to worry about us? Do you find it difficult to relinquish that responsibility in your own life? What about in the lives of others close to you...do you worry about them? Why? According to Matthew 6, what should our responsibility be?
  
- 4) When others around you see you in the midst of a storm, do they see praise or panic? How is our testimony bolstered when we have a heart of praise?
  
- 5) Read Philippians 4:4-7. What does it mean to have a peace that passes understanding? What burden are you carrying around with you that you need to lay before the Lord today? As a group, bring your prayers and supplications before the Lord with thanksgiving.
